Our partnership with Coastal Carolina University's Waccamaw Watershed Academy is going strong. In South Carolina, we've been monitoring Waccamaw water quality since 2006 at 12 sites. In North Carolina, we expanded to 4 sites on Lake Waccamaw and recently we've added 2 river sites. With recent flooding, we've seen dissolved Oxygen levels extremely low.
